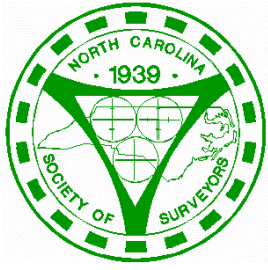

**MIKE BENTON**

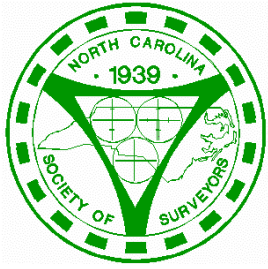

**RANDY RAMBEAU**

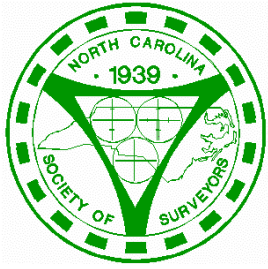
